



2010 MMC/NJMP Drivers Club Race Series



Objective: A private race series for club members of Monticello Motor Club ("MMC") and New Jersey Motorsports Park ("NJMP") only.

Eligible Drivers: Competitors must meet the following pre-requisites:

- Must be a member in good standing of MMC or NJMP.
- The member must hold a recognized competition license with clubs such as SCCA, EMRA, NASA, PCA, etc. **OR** have competed in a previous club racing series, **OR** must attend an approved race class to qualify for the series (see below).
- All drivers must receive approval from the club chief instructor.

Driver Classification: Based on each driver's racing experience, competitors will be classified by the club chief instructor as a Rookie or non-rookie for the entire season.

Eligible Cars/Classes: Any car that is eligible for a NASA class (requires roll cage, fire system, belt). Classes per NASA groupings.

Dates/Format: Eight 30-minute sprint races conducted over 4 weekends at both NJMP and Monticello. Two races will take place on each weekend, and starting positions for the 2nd race will be based on finishing positions from the 1st race. If time permits, there may be additional qualifying sessions.

Rules: NASA Sanctioning Rules for car groupings and all race activities.

Points: NASA point rules. Some minimum points will be awarded to drivers who have no class competition (no other driver is in the class during that race).

Race Winners: Each race will have up to 3 champions per class (1st, 2nd, 3rd) and one Rookie winner per class (who may also have taken a 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place).

Championship: During the awards dinner, for each class, the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place Class and Rookie Challenge winners will be announced. For the overall series, the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place Overall Series Champions and Rookie Challenge Champions will be recognized.

Pricing: Members will be charged \$450 for Day 1 of a race weekend and \$250 for a 2nd day the same weekend. Non-driving guests, including family, will be charged \$25 per person per day.

Meals: A breakfast and lunch buffet are included.

Who May Come: During race days, racers may participate in the race sessions only. The remaining track time will be open track or sessions for driving members of both clubs. Driving guests may accompany members of the hosting track (for example, during a race at MMC, a member of MMC may bring qualified driving guests, and NJMP club members may drive but not bring driving guests). Members may bring non-driving guests to any racing event at either facility.
